Go through your letter with a green pen and make any changes.</p> <p>Check if you have used capital letters.</p> <p>Check if you have used full stops.</p> <p>Check if you have used finger spaces.</p> <p>Think about if you need to add any other information or try to make your work even more exciting by adding some exciting adjectives!</p>	<p>Mash/ask your parent to test you on your spellings.</p> <p><b>Reading: Children</b> will be reading <b>Chapter 5</b> of the book <b>Ned and the jungle animals</b>. Please discuss the story with an adult, explaining what happens in the story.</p> <p><b>Writing Focus: Writing a Letter</b></p> <p><b>Writing Task:</b> We have been working so hard on writing our letter to Ms. Cross this week.</p> <p>Today we are going to write up our letter in our best handwriting making sure that we make any of the changes we edited yesterday.</p>
