

SRS Year 13 'Next Steps' programme – June 2021

This programme is designed to support your preparation for your post-18 plans. The programme is being delivered **remotely** whilst the final stages of A-Level assessment moderation is completed. You must be available to come into school from $7 - 18^{th}$ June if required (you must wear sixth form dress code when coming into school).

All students in Year 13 are required to follow this programme from Monday 7th to Friday 18th June.

What are your next steps?

By now, you will have applied for a degree at University, an apprenticeship or employment - whatever your next steps this programme is relevant to you. In following this programme, you will gain a range of valuable skills that will be beneficial for your next steps and beyond.

How does the programme work?

- > Every morning you will register with your form tutor on Teams between 8.40am and 9am (Your 'attendance' will be monitored, just as it was during remote learning).
- → All sessions are designed to be completed independently and remotely, with access to the resources for each session being found on TEAMS.
- → On TEAMS you will find a Word or PowerPoint document which outlines each session and provides activities for you to complete.
- → You should follow the timetable below to help you manage the completion of all sessions provided.
- → For the Queen Mary University of London (QMUL) workshops, you will be required to log on to an online portal and participate in two virtual presentations. Please note some basic rules for virtual etiquette as you are representing the school when partaking in the virtual presentation:
 - Ensure your camera is turned on and ensure your microphone is muted
 - Ensure you are appropriately dressed i.e. sixth form dress code
 - Ensure you are located in an appropriate place i.e. not sat in bed!
 - Ensure distractions are minimised turn the TV off, put your phone on silent
 - Give the presenter the same level of attention and respect that you would give a live presentation
- → For the Queen Mary University of London (QMUL) workshops, you do not need to register in advance of the session, instead click on the link 15 minutes before the event and follow the steps from the link:
