With 100% pass rate and over 38% of students securing an A\*-A grade, these results are a credit to the students' hard work, resilience and determination, and to the commitment of our staff, whose expertise and ambition for our young people has ensured each student achieves their full potential.

With great results secured, students are now finalising their pathway decisions. Over 50% of students secured their first-choice university place and many are also exploring degree apprenticeships, as they look to make the right decision for them and their next steps.

**Brainard Boateng** celebrates A\*, A\*, A (Business Studies, Sociology & Economics) and is deciding between his first choice university or degree apprenticeship offers for Business, Economics & Finance. **Leena Kanhye** achieved A\*, A, A (Sociology, English Literature, Psychology) to secure her place at **Kings College London** to study Psychology, joined by **Olivia Tinubu** who will study English as she celebrates A\*, A, B (Psychology, English Literature & Sport/PE Studies).

**Nelson Marfo** is the only student to pursue PPE and will take up his place at the **University of Warwick** having achieved A\*, A, A (Maths, Economics & History), **Mahiba Kabir** takes A, A, A to **SOAS** to study International Relations, whilst **Jainlin Wang** pursues Primary Education at the **University of Greenwich** with A\*, A, A, and **Chloe Waterhouse** celebrates A\*, A, A.
