With over 100 A*-A grades, 61% of students securing an A*-B grade and an overall average grade B, these results are a credit to the students' hard work, resilience and determination, and to the commitment of our staff, whose expertise and ambition for our young people has ensured each student achieves their full potential.

As a school we are particularly pleased to celebrate the progress our students have made over the last two years, with many achieving much higher grades than targeted.
