




# **OUR SCHOOL'S PROUD HISTORY**

The first school on this site was Dagenham County High School which was finished in 1935. This was the building we call Shaftesbury. In those days, it was known as a grammar school. In 1970 comprehensive schools were introduced to Barking and Dagenham and several schools, including Dagenham County High, joined together to become Parsloes Manor Comprehensive School.

In 1990 Parsloes Manor was joined by two other schools to become The Sydney Russell School. The school was named in honour of Sydney Russell who did lots of good work in the local community. The names of our buildings recognise the work of others in the community.

As the school became even more successful and popular, we had to expand and, in 2013 a multi-million pound building programme was completed. In 2014, Sydney Russell became an "all through" school with a primary department and in 2015 we became the first academy in Barking and Dagenham.

In July 2015, we marked our Silver Jubilee with a visit from Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II and His Royal Highness Prince Phillip. The Queen and His Royal Highness visited some lessons, saw a display of cycle polo and enjoyed a concert of classical music. The Queen also unveiled the plaque marking the completion of the redevelopment of the school which you can still see in our Atrium. A visit by the Queen was a fitting way to celebrate all we have achieved so far!

# **WORLD-CLASS FACILITIES**

The Sydney Russell School has some of the best facilities in the country.

#### Classrooms

Our light and airy classrooms are the largest in the country. There is a large number of classrooms across the school which are equipped with 32 computers for students to use and overhead projectors

We also have a range of specialist classrooms including:

- A suite of music classrooms and practice rooms
- A dance studio with barre
- Two drama studios, one of which has tiered seating for performances
- Two floors of dedicated computing classrooms
- Three purpose built kitchens for Food Technology
- Two technology workshops

#### **Sports Facilities**

We have some of the best sports facilities in the country including:

- A spacious Sports Hall
- A state-of-the-art fitness suite
- Grass pitches for team sports and athletics
- 5G Football Pitch
- Two hard-courts

#### Science Laboratories

Our Science faculty has 12 purpose-built laboratories with state of the art facilities.


#### Library

# AN EXCEPTIONAL EDUCATION

At The Sydney Russell School, the combination of traditional values, high quality teaching based on the latest research and modern facilities will ensure that your child will be successful and happy.

#### Grouping of Students

At Sydney Russell, students are grouped by ability from the start of Year 7. Students are placed in a form on the basis of their KS2 results. Year 7 students are taught in form groups within their band. Students sit formal assessments twice a year, the results of which are used to review the forms and bands in which students are placed. We offer bespoke programmes of enhancement activities for all students in addition to their lessons.

#### A Broad Curriculum

Our broad and challenging curriculum promotes the highest academic standards without compromising the opportunities students have to learn music, art, drama and dance. As part of our commitment to the arts, we joined the MISST programme in 2020 enabling all students from Year 7 to be taught a musical instrument in their music lessons.

In 2019, we also became an **OLEVI** Designated Centre of Excellence in teaching and learning, the only school designated in London.

#### Sixth Form

Most of our students continue to our Sixth Form when they complete their GCSEs due to its continued success. 

#### MiSST Programme

We are proud to be part of the MiSST Programme. As part of the Music in Secondary School's Trust program (MiSST), every Year 7 will be learning an orchestral instrument over the course of this year with opportunities for further continuation thereafter. This is a fantastic opportunity and one which our school is very lucky to be able to offer as it is usually only afforded to Private Schools. We are, in fact, the only state school in the borough to be part of this. Students will be loaned an instrument and initial accessories to join 22 MiSST schools across the country, all offering bespoke music tuition to young people, free of charge. There are trips, workshops and national events. At the end of Year 7 students are given the chance to opt into the programme, continuing their education in orchestral music, into Year 8 and further.
